## Key Benefits

**Offline access to downloaded resources:** Connect to the internet to download resources from within the mobile app. Once you've downloaded them, you can use them offline — anywhere, anytime.

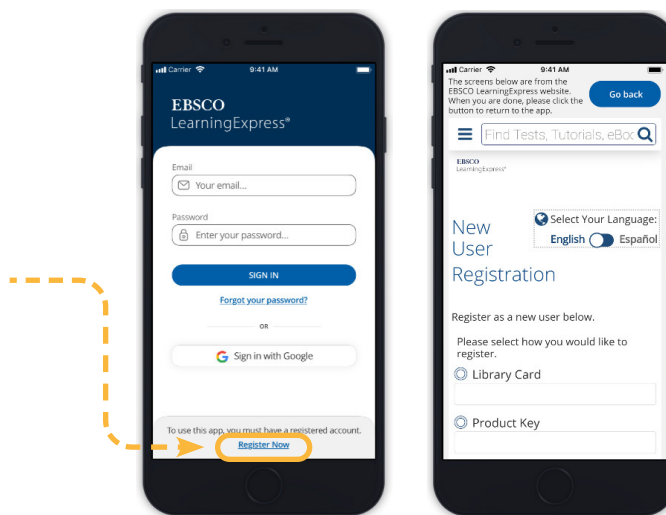
**Intuitive user experience:** Access hundreds of practice tests, microlessons e-books, articles and flashcards in a modern, user-friendly app.

**Multi-device support:** Download resources to as many devices (e.g., smartphones, tablets) as needed. *Note: Work completed using the mobile app will not sync with the desktop platform at this time.*

## Getting Started

The LearningExpress Mobile App is available for iOS and Android devices and can be downloaded from the iTunes and Google Play app stores.

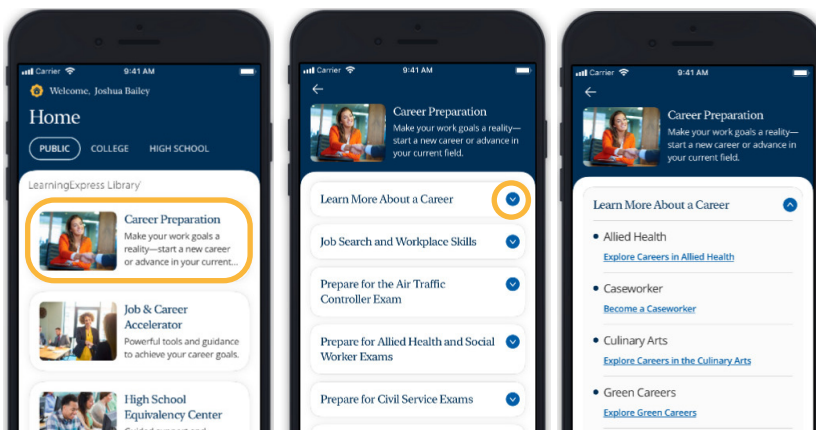
1. To create a new account, you must first register as a user with LearningExpress through your library. Click the **Register Now** link, select your preferred language, and enter your library card number or product key.
2. Once you've registered, click the **Go back** button to return to the app. You may now log in to the app using your new account credentials.

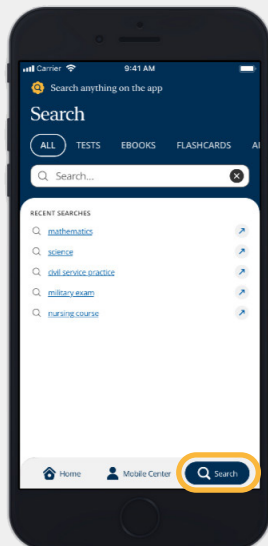
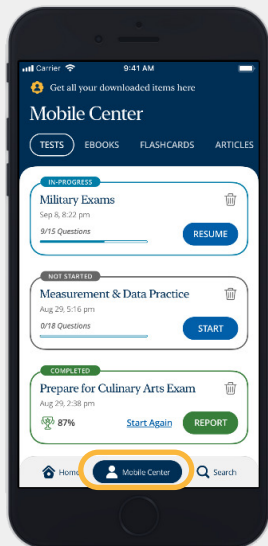


## Home Screen & Learning Centers

From the home screen, you may have the option of accessing different LearningExpress resources by toggling by library type.

1. Click on a learning center, such as **Career Preparation**, to view a list of categories. →
2. Click the **blue arrow** to expand the category.
3. Click a topic link to browse individual tests, e-books, flashcards and articles — all of which can be downloaded for offline use.





## Mobile Center

Click the **Mobile Center** button at the bottom of the screen to access downloaded tests, e-books, flashcards and articles.

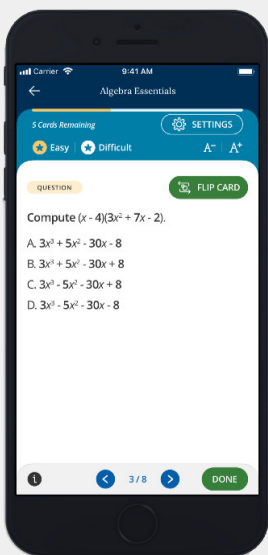
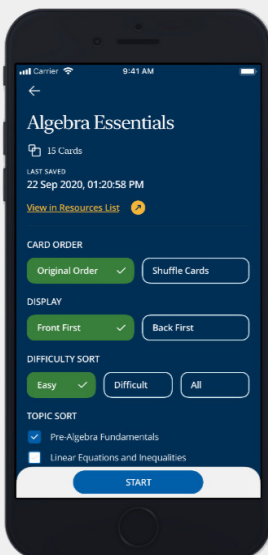
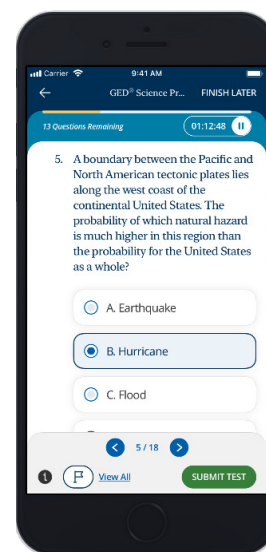
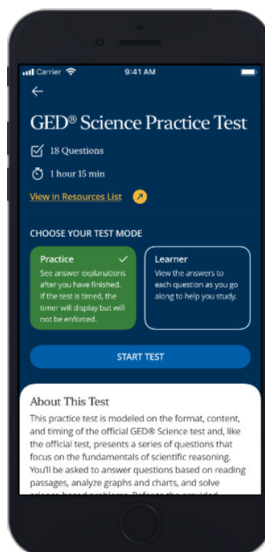
## Search

Click the **Search** button at the bottom of the screen to search for tests, e-books, flashcards and articles. Your recent searches will display. Click the "x" to remove saved searches.

## Taking a Practice Test

For each practice test, the user can see the number of questions and how long the test is expected to take.

1. Choose your **Test Mode**.
  - **Practice Mode:** See answer explanations only after all questions are completed. If the test is timed, a timer will display, but is not enforced.
  - **Learner Mode:** View answers to each question as you go.
2. Click **Start Test** to begin.
3. Click **Finish Later** in upper right corner to save your progress and return to the test at a later time.
4. Click **Submit Test** to see your score report and check your answers.



## Practicing with Flashcards

1. Choose your **Card Order, Display, Difficulty Sort** and **Topic Sort**.
2. Click the **Start** button to begin.
3. Once you've solved the question, click **Flip Card** to see the answer.
4. Use the **blue arrows** to navigate through the flashcards.
5. Click the **Done** button when finished.
