- 2. Search Modes:** Search using Basic or Advanced mode, or add filters such as Peer-Reviewed and Full Text.
- 3. Facets:** Filter search results by source type, related subjects and more.
- 4. Limit your results:** Refine your searches without navigating away from the results page.
- 5. Projects Folder:** Create a personal My EBSCOhost folder to save articles, links to searches, images and more.
- 6. Publications Browse:** Find articles by browsing publications available in Education Source.
- 7. Access Options:** Find article formats to view or download.
