

A featured content carousel gives prominence to valuable, thematic e-book and video content, when available.





Resources for Promotion and Engagement

Marketing plays a vital role in building community awareness of the information resources and services that your library provides. Both digital marketing strategies and in-library promotional materials increase your chances of reaching a wider audience and boosting usage of Explora. Here are some strategies for success:

Website Promotion and Direct Links

Your website is your library's virtual front door. A well-designed library website makes it easier for users to discover all the library has to offer. You can drive traffic to your Explora resources by providing direct links from your library homepage. To assist with building direct links, you can use our **Direct URL Builder**

When designing your website, it's important to provide clear wayfinding for users. If you haven't already, talk to your EBSCO team members about setting up different Explora profiles by age group (e.g., kids, teens and adults). Then, provide separate links for these audiences, with additional color-coding and clear navigation paths to make it easier for users to get to their destination.

Digital and Printable Materials

Library signs can be navigational, informational and promotional. They communicate news, upcoming events, policies and directions — but can also promote your library resources!

Various types of customizable materials available in our **Explora promotion kit**:

Posters can be hung in strategic locations, such as near public computers, by the reference desk, and on information boards.

Digital Signage such as screensavers can be displayed on your library's public monitors to keep the messaging fresh.

To engage and inform library users who are always on the go, it's also a good idea to maintain a small stock of printed promotional materials that they can take with them.

Handouts can be made available at the circulation desk, hung on bulletin boards, or even distributed digitally to library staff.

Bookmarks are easy to grab and contain digestible information or quick instructions. Keep a pile on the circulation desk, or include them in your pick-up orders to spread the word to your engaged patrons!

Social Media

Your social media strategy helps you reach users outside of the library's four walls. Not only can you promote new books, events and programs to attract users to the library, but you can also use social media to increase awareness of the library's digital resources.

Here are some additional tips:

- 1. Know when members of your target audience are active on social media your workforce members may be checking their feed with their morning coffee, while your students may take an after-class social media break.
- 2. Schedule your posts for consistency. As you build an engaged audience, they'll want to know when they'll hear from you. This also gives you plenty of time to tweak and proof your posts ahead of time.

- 3. Include two to three hashtags to boost visibility and organize your posts. Hashtags can lead users to other posts about that topic, making it easy for them to find content that interests them. You may want to make and use your own library hashtag, and get your audience using it.
- 4. Maintain a consistent voice to connect with your followers. To appeal to Gen Z and younger audiences, use a more casual and playful tone. You may want to stay up to date on the latest trends and memes.
